SCIENTIFIC CRITERIA FOR SUBMISSIONS**

Subject Matter

Rapid Communications are research papers that deal with all aspects of medical and veterinary entomology/acarology

Size of Articles

Maximum 2,000 words (including tables and references)

Criteria for Submissions

Articles must:

- be distinctive, timely, and of special interest to the readership.
- describe innovative or pioneering research, or present unique and new concepts in the subject matter area.
- be enhanced by rapid publication in that the article has a high profile and is need-to-know information by the readership.
- be pre-reviewed by at least 3 experts in the subject matter area if possible.

Author

Submits manuscript with cover letter that outlines:

- A summary of the article
- Why rapid communication is warranted
- Names, addresses, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses of pre-reviewers if applicable.

Editor

Determines suitability for Rapid Communications based on:

- Pre-reviewer's comments
- Consultation with members of the JME Editorial Board
- Other opinions as needed.

If found suitable for publication as Rapid Communication:

- Formal review completed within 3 weeks from submission date.
- Publication of accepted papers in 4-5 months.

If not suited for publication as Rapid Communication:

- Automatically submitted for publication as Short Communications

Editorial Charges

- \$96 per page for ESA members.
- \$150 per page for nonmembers.

Authors who are employed and are ESA members but have no grants or funds for publication can request a partial waiver of editorial charges.
