STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE NCB GOVERNING BOARD: Thanks to the six students who agreed to be nominated for the position of student representative to the ESA-NCB Executive Committee. The nominees are: Matthew Ethington (Purdue University), Todd Johnson (University of Illinois), Priyanka Mittapelly (The Ohio State University), Jacob Pecenka (Purdue University), Erika Peirce (Colorado State University), and Hailey Shanovich (University of Minnesota). Student members of the NCB will be sent information about the nominees and how to vote.

LINNAEAN GAMES PREPARATION: The deadline for signing up Linnaean teams to compete at the 2018 NBC-ESA meetings in Madison, WI will be Monday, 8 January 2018. The competition will be limited to a maximum of 10 teams. The first team from each university will be given priority, but an additional team from a given university could be considered toward the deadline if it is helpful in filling out a 10-team slate. Departments wishing to submit a team should contact Daniel Young (young@entomology.wisc.edu) and provide (1) names of up to four team members, (2) up to two alternates, and (3) the coach name(s) by Monday, 8 January 2018. As began in 2017, the Linnaean Games Committee is requesting the coach(es) from each registered team to submit a [16] toss-up question set for the games. Questions will be sorted and randomized so that no team receives a question they submitted. Question sets should be sent to Dan Young for vetting any time after the team has been entered, but not later than Monday, Monday, 15 January 2018. Once vetted, questions will be aggregated and randomized by NCB Linnaean Gamesmaster, Deane Jorgenson.



- Organizer names and contact information
