Issues:

Purpose of Emergency and Temporary Labels

- Specific needs which have been documented
- Limited geographical range (often)
- Characteristic of control losses
 - increased economic loss / uncontrolled pest density
 - reduced length of control / reduced % control / use of slightly higher rates
 - increased application frequency
- Value to EPA decision process of some local early use
- Other issues with new chemistry might be involved
- New priority with certain environmental concerns (i.e. bees)

 - manage insecticide resistance
