2. Certification

Current ACEs and BCEs who are now retired from active service but would still like to retain their certification may be able to convert to Emeritus status. Contact bce@entsoc.org. Non-member ACEs have access to ESA *eNews* and receive an online subscription to *American Entomologist*.

3. Sections and Branches

You may belong to one Section and one Branch with no additional fees incurred. If you would like to join additional Sections or Branches, there is a \$25 charge for each. The ESA Sections are: Medical, Urban, and Veterinary Entomology; Physiology, Biochemistry, and Toxicology; Plant-Insect Ecosystems, and; Systematics, Evolution, and Biodiversity. The ESA Branches are Eastern, International, North Central, Pacific, Southeastern, and Southwestern.

4. & 5. Publications & Postage

Members have online access to the ESA journals for free, starting at Volume 1. That's more than 160 issues of each journal! *AE* and *eNews* are free to members, although a postage charge is required for *AE* delivery outside the US and Canada.

ESA members also are entitled to discounted print subscriptions. US and Canadian subscriptions-class postage is included in the purchase price. International subscriptions that do not include postage will not be processed. Surface mail does not apply; airmail postage is required to increase deliverability.
